The specific outcomes of this workshop are to:

- Understand mātauranga Māori and "mana ōrite"
- Build teacher capability around culturally inclusive NCEA and assessment practice
- Integrate te ao Māori and mātauranga Māori into the new 'graduate profile' for NCEA
- Develop standards to make sure that mātauranga Māori is acknowledged and credentialed equally in NCEA Level 1 English
- Develop new assessment resources a for mātauranga Māori in NCEA Level 1 English.
- Understanding Māori-centered contexts for examples and assessment resources e.g. local iwi history in NCEA Level 1 English.
